Value 5 – Teamwork

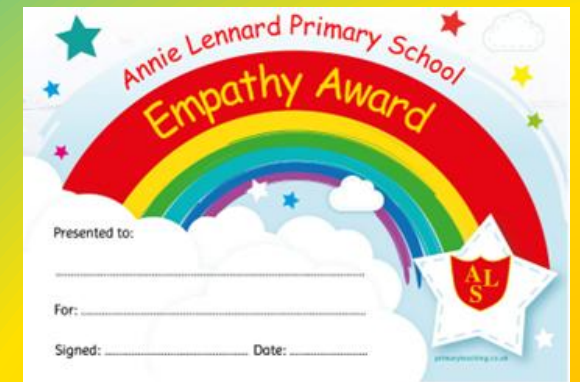

We understand that we are all part of the Annie Lennard family.

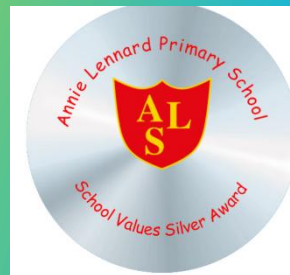
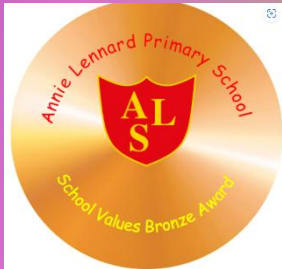

Our Values Reward System
